Since its founding in 1968, HMTA's mission has been "To promote the professional growth and development of its' members and to further the art of music by providing programs that encourage and support teaching, performance, composition, and scholarly research." HMTA always hopes to plan events which will fulfill the purpose of our organization. Here's a look back at the events that HMTA provided this past year.

- **September 2009:** The Annual Membership/Business Meeting was held at the Wai'olae Country Club. A workshop entitled "Sustainable Teaching/Recession Proofing Your Studio" was presented by Helen Chao-Casano.
- **October 2009:** HMTA member, Elaine Lu, reinstates the HMTA Student Recitals, the first of which was held on October 31, 2009 at UH Manoa, Room 36. Many students participated and also performed in costume!
- **November 2009:** HMTA holds the 42nd Annual Convention with events at UH Manoa and Mozart Music House.
